Monday to Thursday - 9:30am to 4:30pm (Closed Statutory Holidays)

Snow - Please do not shovel snow from your driveway into the street. Instead, **pile it on your own property** to keep roads clear and safe for everyone. Thank you!

Vehicles Parked on the Roadway – Please do not let your vehicle sit on the roadway. No vehicle can park on a roadway for more than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours, in accordance with Bylaw 2015-07 (Traffic Bylaw)

All trailers and equipment should be parked on your own property, not on the roadway.

Utility Billing- Please send in meter reading in last week of each month. If you are unsure if you have a meter that requires you to submit a reading, please contact the office.

Recycle/Garbage Bins - Please remember to put your bin out the night before collection day to make sure it is collected. Make sure to remove your bin off the street in a timely matter. Bins should be removed from the street by the following day after collection. If you have multiple bins together, please make sure there is 4 feet in between them to be collected.

Outstanding Bills- Utility Bills that are in Arrears (over 30 Days) have been transferred to your Taxes at December 31, 2025. If you have renters and these fees are not paid, they will also go on your Taxes.

Taxes- On January 1, 2026, a 12% interest fee was added to any tax accounts that are outstanding.

Speed Within the Village – Please be mindful of your speed while driving through the Village. The speed limit in the Village is 40km/h & 30km/h in playground zones. Watch carefully for children playing with in the Village and for those walking to and from school.

Home- Based Business - You are required a Yearly Business license to run a home-based business. Business License for 2026 are now available at the Village office.

Dog & Cat Licenses - Reminder that both cats and dogs need to be licensed annually, January 1 to December 31. Pet licenses are due now for 2026 can be purchased at the Village office.
