Outstanding Bills- As the year is just about over, this is a reminder that **Utility Bills** that are in Arrears (over 30 Days) will be transferred to your Taxes at December 31,2024. If you have renters and these fees are not paid, they will also go on your Taxes.

<u>Taxes-</u> Taxes are due December 31,2024. If your Taxes are not paid, on January 1, 2025, a 12% interest fee will be added to your tax account.

Home-Based Business

You are required a Yearly Business license to run a home-based business. Business License for 2025 are now available at the Village office.

Dog & Cat Licenses



Reminder that both cats and dogs need to be licensed annually, January 1 to December 31. Pet licenses for 2025 can be purchased at the Village office.

Snow Removal Assistance

If you are a homeowner aged 65 or older, or if you are physically disabled and unable to clear your snow, the Village offers assistance.

How to Request Assistance:

- 1. **Fill Out a Form**: You must complete a form with your name, address, and phone number at the Village office. You can request the form to be sent to you.
- 2. No Charge: Snow will be removed at no charge, depending on availability.

Priority Areas:

- Main roadways and emergency routes will be cleared first.
- Please note that the Village does not have a grader or bobcat, so snow ridges in driveways may not be cleared.
- Lane and alleyways will be addressed as time allows.

Additional Services:

• For other snow removal requests, such as driveway clearing, fees will apply. Please contact the office for a Contract Work Application Form.

Ways to pay for Utilities, Taxes, Dog/Cat Licenses -etc.

- E-transfer We have auto deposit so no need for passwords. Please put in the notes of your e-transfer your Civic address, Name and what you are paying taxes, utilities, dog/cat licence etc. Send e-transfer to clavetvillage@sasktel.net
- We accept Credit Cards, Debit Cards, Cheques and Cash
- TD or Credit Union check with these institutions on their transfer methods.
- The Village Office has a secure lock box on the building, where cheques/items may be dropped off.

You can also contact your bank to see if you can pay your utilities and taxes through your bank.
