Taxes:

- **Discounts are available on Municipal Tax portion ONLY**
- ** A 3% Discount is available until October 31, 2025

No discounts are available on School Taxes and Local Improvement Levies

** Tax Payments are due by December 31, 2025

A 12% Penalty will be added January 1, 2026, to Any Outstanding Taxes.

- E-transfer We have auto deposit so no need for passwords. Please put in the notes of your e-transfer your Civic address, Name and what you are paying taxes, utilities, dog/cat licence etc. Send e-transfer to clavetvillage@sasktel.net
- We accept Credit Cards, Debit Cards, Cheques and Cash
- TD or Credit Union check with these institutions on their transfer methods.
- The Village Office has a secure lock box on the building, where cheques/items may be dropped off.

Snow Removal Assistance

If you are a homeowner aged 65 or older, or if you are physically disabled and unable to clear your snow, the Village offers assistance.

How to Request Assistance:

- 1. **Fill Out a Form**: You must complete a form with your name, address, and phone number at the Village office. You can request the form to be sent to you.
- 2. No Charge: Snow will be removed at no charge, depending on availability.

Priority Areas:

- Main roadways and emergency routes will be cleared first.
- Please note that the Village does not have a grader or bobcat, so snow ridges in driveways may not be cleared.
- Lane and alleyways will be addressed as time allows.

Additional Services:

• For other snow removal requests, such as driveway clearing, fees will apply. Please contact the office for a Contract Work Application Form.

Position:

Casual Public Works Labourer

- Cleaning and maintenance of Village equipment or facilities

- Experience with equipment (e.g., mower, trimmer, snow blower, tractor) is an asset
- Safety certifications (e.g., First Aid, WHMIS) are considered an asset

- Wage based on experience and qualifications
