SNOW REMOVAL:

ANY Homeowner(65 years of age or older) who needs assistance and/or persons who are Physically Disabled and are Unable to Clear their snow and need the Villages' assistance ----- You MUST fill in a form stating your name, address and phone number at the Village office. The snow will be removed at no charge (as time permits) a Form Must be filled in. The office can send you this – upon request.

The Main Roadways & Emergency Routes are cleared first.

- The Village does Not own a Grader or Bobcat, therefore, snow ridges in the driveways may not be cleared. ** Lane and alley-ways will be cleared as time permits.
- Any other snow removal requests (ie: Driveways) will be charged a fee. Please contact the office for a Contract Work Application Form.

<u>Outdoor Rink</u> Provincial Health Order Rules - must be followed if you plan on using the ice surface.

<u>2021 - Yearly Dog and Cat Licenses</u> - can be purchased now – (form attached)

<u>Community Living</u> - Yellow Clothing Bin – is located by the Village Shop (3rd Ave) Donations can be dropped off any time.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - Unpaid Billings: We are nearing Year End.

This is a reminder that any **Utility Bills** (arrears) NOT paid by December 31, 2020 will be moved to the Tax Roll of the property owner and will be assessed a 12% penalty on January 1, 2021.

<u>TAX Reminder</u>- Taxes are due by December 31/2020. As of January 1, 2021 a 12 % penalty will be applied and Tax Enforcement proceedings - may be implemented for any unpaid amounts. Outstanding Water Bills added to the Taxes at Year End will have a 12% penalty added.

Methods of payment for Taxes, Utility bills, Dog Tags - etc.

- 1. *E transfers -Please send the Village of Clavet an email indicating a password you are using.*
- 2. Posted dated cheques
- 3. We accept, Credit Card, Debit, Cheques or Cash
- 4. TD Bank or Credit Union check with these institutions on their simple and convenient electronic transfers.
- 5. The Village Office has a secure lock box on the building, where cheques/items may be dropped off.
