BYLAW 2010-11 NUISANCE ABATEMENT BYLAW

We would like to remind everybody of the above noted Bylaw, the Nuisance Abatement Bylaw as it pertains to your property in the village. Please review the Bylaw and take note of the sections regarding **dilapidated buildings, unoccupied buildings, overgrown grass and weeds, untidy and unsightly property, junked vehicles, open excavations, maintenance of yards and outdoor storage of materials.** We thank you for your attention and understanding in this matter.

BYLAW 2010-12 ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW

We would like to remind our community residents that according to the above noted Bylaw, all dogs, cats and other type of household pets must be licensed and kept from running at large – please use the village dog park if you wish to have your dog(s) off leash.

Another item that has been brought to our attention is an increasing amount of dog defecation in public greenspaces and alleyways. Excerpt from the above noted Bylaw states the following:

“Section 9 (a) If a dog or cat defecates on any public or private property other than the owner’s the owner of the dog/cat shall cause such defecation to removed immediately, and: (i) An owner or occupant of private property shall not allow animal feces to accumulate on the property so as to create a health hazard (ii) If requested to do so by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or public health inspector, the owner or occupant of private property must remove all animal feces from the property within 72 hours of the time request is made; (iii) If the request under sub-section i) is made to an occupant of private property, a copy of the request shall also be sent by certified mail to the owner of the property at the mailing address shown on the last revised assessment roll of the Village 9(b) The Village may remove the feces from the property if: (i) The person to whom the request is made fails to remove the feces within 72 hours of request; or (ii) After reasonable inquiry of the whereabouts of the owner or occupant of the property cannot be determined 9(c) If the Village carries out the work under sub-section b), the costs and expenses incurred are considered a debt due to the Village and the village may take the appropriate actions necessary to recover the incurred costs for such work.”



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We would also like to advise that we have added a “dog poop” bag station at the green space beside the baseball diamonds for convenience.
