Ways to pay for Utilities, Taxes, Dog/Cat Licenses -etc.

- E-transfer – We have auto deposit so no need for passwords. Please put in the notes of your e-transfer your Civic address, Name and what you are paying taxes, utilities, dog/cat licence etc. Send e-transfer to clavetvillage@sasktel.net
- We accept – Credit Cards, Debit Cards, Cheques and Cash
- Bill payments through financial institution - **TD, Credit Union, Conexus & Scotiabank**
- The Village Office has a secure lock box on the building, where cheques/items may be dropped off.

Utility Billing- Please send in meter reading in last week of each month. If you are unsure if you have a meter that requires you to submit a reading, please contact the office.

Recycle/Garbage Bins - Please remember to put your bin out the night before collection day to make sure it is collected. Make sure to remove your bin off the street in a timely matter. Bins should be removed from the street by the following day after collection. If you have multiple bins together, please make sure there is 4 feet in between them to be collected.

Speed Within the Village – Please be mindful of your speed while driving through the Village. The speed limit in the Village is 40km/h & 30km/h in playground zones. Watch carefully for children playing with in the Village and for those walking to and from school.

Home- Based Business - You are required a Yearly Business license to run a home-based business. Business License for 2026 are now available at the Village office.

Dog & Cat Licenses - Reminder that both cats and dogs need to be licensed annually, January 1 to December 31. Pet licenses are due now for 2026 can be purchased at the Village office.

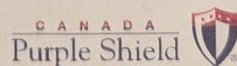
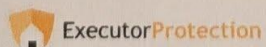
