****Discounts are available on Municipal Tax portion ONLY****

**** A 5% Discount is available until September 30, 2024**

**** A 3% Discount is available until October 31, 2024**

No discounts are available on School Taxes and Local Improvement Levies

**** Tax Payments are due by December 31, 2024**

A 12% Penalty will be added January 1, 2025, to Any Outstanding Taxes.

Ways to pay for Utilities, Taxes, Dog/Cat Licenses -etc.

- E-transfer – We have auto deposit so no need for passwords. Please put in the notes of your e-transfer your Civic address, Name and what you are paying taxes, utilities, dog/cat licence etc. Send e-transfer to clavetvillage@sasktel.net
- We accept – Credit Cards, Debit Cards, Cheques and Cash
- TD or Credit Union – check with these institutions on their transfer methods.
- The Village Office has a secure lock box on the building, where cheques/items may be dropped off.

You can also contact your bank to see if you can pay your utilities and taxes through your bank.
